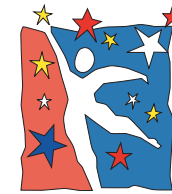

## Oasis Rehabilitation Center



Oasis Rehabilitation Center provides quality mental health treatment services for adults in a safe and secure locked environment. It offers two separate programs within a single facility: a Psychiatric Health Facility (PHF) and a Mental Health Rehabilitation Center (MHRC). Each unit is separately licensed by the California Department of Mental Health and has its own distinct treatment programs. In addition, each unit has its own multidisciplinary staff of highly qualified mental health professionals. Both units provide services in coordination with Riverside County Department of Mental Health.

### Psychiatric Health Facility (PHF)

Oasis PHF is a locked program that offers comprehensive psychological and physical assessment, evaluation, and treatment for adults “in crisis” with serious and immediate psychiatric disturbances. This facility specializes in rapid short-term stabilization, close supervision, intensive treatment, and social service support.

### Mental Health Rehabilitation Center (MHRC)

Oasis MHRC is a locked unit specializing in intensive psychiatric rehabilitation and psychosocial skills training for mentally ill adults. The MHRC is a safe therapeutic environment where clients learn and practice psychosocial, independent living, and prevocational skills. Structured activities, role-playing, goal setting, and supported practice in community settings are among the activities in the MHRC. Here, clients and their families learn to use community resources to support the successful transition to community living.

### Eligibility and Referrals

Referrals for Oasis Rehabilitation Center come from the Riverside County Department of Mental Health with funding through Short-Doyle/Medi-Cal.

### A Commitment to Quality

Oasis staff and administration are committed to providing the highest quality of care. Standardized measures of treatment outcomes, Total Quality Management programs, client satisfaction surveys, and the ongoing cultural competency training of all staff members help Oasis meet and exceed the rigorous criteria of local and state agencies.
