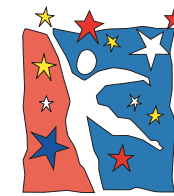

Community-Based Services

School-based services are a primary focus of Star View Community Services, including school consultation and intervention. Services are coordinated with district and local school personnel to achieve effective referral and treatment for children who have serious emotional and/or behavioral problems. In addition, after-school group services are offered for young people who need more support than individual counseling.

In-home services help identify and meet the needs of children with a mental illness and their families. In-home services consist of assessment, consultation, case management, individual and family counseling, and crisis intervention. In-home services can be combined with school-based services.

Clinic-based services are available as an alternative to in-home or school-based services.

An individualized and highly flexible approach helps youngsters thrive in school and family or community living environments.

Star View staff members collaborate with school personnel, parents and guardians, and other community agencies to achieve goals established by the student, family, and treatment professionals. Care is provided by dedicated and experienced staff, including licensed psychiatrists, psychologists, marriage and family therapists, social workers, support counselors, and nurses.

Star View's **School-Based Services** are based on the belief that families should participate in the treatment of their youngsters. Star View Community Services' School-Based Services offer a team approach to treatment which is based on establishing relationships with schools, families, foster families, and community programs to provide the highest quality of care in the client's home or school or in convenient locations throughout much of Los Angeles County. Families are also linked with the community services they need to support the youth in treatment.



Eligibility and Referrals

Star View's **School-Based Services** are available to young people between the ages of 5 and 21 who reside in Los Angeles County and who have serious emotional and/or behavioral problems at home and/or at school.

Referrals may be made by schools and school districts, school teachers or counselors, or family members. Services are reimbursed through Medi-Cal, AB3632, or alternative funding. Referral to other service providers may be made for children covered by private insurance.

Star View's **School-Based Services** staff and administration are committed to providing the highest quality of care. Standardized measures of treatment outcomes, Total Quality Management programs, client satisfaction surveys, and the ongoing cultural competency training of all staff members help Star View meet and exceed the rigorous criteria of local and state agencies.
